As a member of the club you will be able to take part in youth coaching, hire the club boats to sail at other times and use all the club facilities. Junior members do not have to do duties, but we do ask our adult members to help with running the club. We have lots of families and juniors at the club, and you will always find some of them around at the weekends and on summer sailing evenings.

What will it cost?

For details of our current rates please have a look at our website or come down during sailing times. Typical costs for a family membership are in the region of £200 for the year – that's under £20 per month for a family of four. Junior memberships are available from £50, but you will need at least one adult social membership as well. We charge fees for each craft kept at the Club by members.

The Club caters for sailors of all abilities, and in 2012 we were awarded 'RYA Club of the Year' in recognition of the range and quality of sailing activities we provide.

Why Sailing?

Sailing is a great way for children to have fun with friends in a relaxed outdoor environment. However, learning to sail also develops confidence, independence, communication, leadership, teamwork and creativity. Academically it links with many aspects of the curriculum including geography, science and maths as well as sport. As an RYA training centre, we offer high standards of instruction in a safe and proven structure. We have a full training programme booked for 2021—although this is subject to change based on covid restrictions. All training carried out will comply with Government and RYA guidelines to ensure everyone is kept safe.

We offer Junior Start Sailing courses at a weekends or after school on Tuesdays. On this course children (8 years +) learn to how to sail a small boat out onto the lake and back to the beach, as well as finding out more about boats and sailing (RYA Stage 1 Certificate).

RYA Stage 1 Course Dates for 2021

Sun mornings 11 & 25/4, 9 & 23/5

Sat/Sun 5 & 6 June

Tuesday eves 8 to 29 June

Sat/Sun 11 & 12 September

Courses cost £55 and are either 2 days or 4 mornings or evenings. Courses are for age 8 and above



Youth Coaching and More

Once kids have RYA Stage 1, members can join in youth coaching on Sunday mornings at the club. They can sail with friends, have fun, learn to sail better and start racing. Youth coaching happens roughly every other Sunday from March to October. **It costs £45 per year plus boat hire fees or you can use your own boat.**

There are other fun events for juniors at Hollowell too like the family fun day and pirates day - free for members.

Many of our young members go on to join RYA squads and compete regionally, nationally or even internationally. Others develop their leadership, independence and communication skills by qualifying as instructors and teaching sailing at the club or elsewhere. Some just want to be out on the water having fun - and that's fine too!

Sail in the Summer Holidays

Youth Week - Sailing and Windsurfing!



Youth week is a fun week during the summer school holidays when we have 2 days of windsurfing followed by 3 days of dinghy sailing. There will be 3 or 4 groups of sailors from beginners to good sailors working on RYA certificates. On the last day you can show off your sailing skills when we sail across the lake for a picnic and teams compete in a fun treasure hunt on the water. An ideal staycation activity for 2021!

How Long is the course?: You can do just 2 days of windsurfing or just 3 days of sailing, or you can do all 5 days of water sports

What will I be doing?: If you are a beginner, you can learn to launch and steer a small boat and get an RYA stage 1 certificate. If you already have stage 1 we also do stage 2,3 or 4 certificates and some of the more advanced courses. You can also learn to windsurf or improve your windsurfing (we don't award RYA certificates for windsurfing)

Costs: Members: £55 Windsurfing, £75 Sailing, £110 for both, Non-members: £90 Windsurfing, £125 Sailing, £185 for both
